




### Kids receiving pocket money


How many children receive pocket money and how often?



### 56% of kids aged 4-11 receive pocket money; as expected there are more as they get older









### As households get more affluent, the number of kids receiving pocket money income increases










### Interestingly, the more they use screens, the more they get pocket money: touchpoint!





72% of kids who receive pocket money, receive it occasionally. As kids get older, they are slightly more likely to receive pocket money on a monthly basis.





Frequency of receiving pocket money France – Kids 4-11










### Although occasional is the key frequency of giving pocket money to 4-11 years old kids, a more regular frequency increase as kids get older.








### As households get more affluent, the number of kids receiving weekly income increases








### The size of the household does not impact the part of kids receiving pocket money



Frequency of receiving pocket money By number of persons in household France – kids 4-11








#### The same pattern applies to the digital users, as well as collectors








# Compare to their international counter-parts, French kids are less to receive pocket money than most of the countries surveyed. 80% of the British kids receive pocket money




### Children who receive pocket money receive between 14 \$ and 16 \$ per month depending on age






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









#### Not only there are less kids receiving pocket money in France than in most of the other surveyed countries, but also when they do, they tend to receive less!










### French kids aged 7-11 receive 56% of what their American counterparts receive!

Ranked by decreasing order of monthly pocket money amounts






### British parents give a total of €1.5 billion in pocket money to their kids 4 to 11: twice as much than France

Ranked by decreasing order of annual pocket money market sizes






### Candies, gums, snack or drinks are the first expenses with kids 4-11, followed by books, comics or magazines


Parents are predominately concerned with teaching their kids to spend wisely ... although they do not seem to need any and that's the reason for a large 'no pocket money' group in France.










### **Executive Summary**







- 56% of kids aged 4-11 receive pocket money. Most of them (72%) receive pocket money occasionally.
- The more they use screens, the more they get allocated to pocket money. The same patterns applies to the kids having a collection.
- Compare to their international counter-parts, French kids are less to receive pocket money than most of the countries surveyed. As a matter of fact, 80% of the British kids receive pocket money.
- French kids 4 to 11 are allocated an average of €15.30 per month, twice as less as the American kids.
- As a result, the total market value for this pocket money among kids 4 to 11 adds to €796 million.







- 87% of parents are predominately concerned with teaching their children to spend their money wisely
- Parents mainly consider Pocket Money as a tool to guide/teach their children the value of the money; especially among the younger ones. As kids get older, money is used as a reward (and more likely as a punishment for the opposite)
  - 48% of children receive pocket money when they help around the house and 40% of kids receive pocket money when they get good grades at school
  - 75% of parents disagree that their child buys rubbish with their money and agree with what they spend their money on
- 47% of parents give their kids money when they need it
- 59% of parents agree that their child doesn't need money. Instead, when they want something, we buy it for them.
